**Four New Overseers Appointed**

SAN MARINO, Calif. – Four new members have been appointed to the Board of Overseers at The Huntington Library, Art Collections, and Botanical Gardens. The Overseers are a group of 60 business and community leaders who work closely with Huntington trustees and senior staff in the planning and execution of programs to advance the institution's mission.

**Olin Barrett** was raised in the Pasadena area and received a bachelor's degree in English from Stanford and an MBA from Harvard. He became involved with The Huntington as a garden docent in 1998 after his retirement from the investment firm of Scudder, Stevens, & Clark, where he was managing director. Barrett serves on two Overseers' Committees: Planned Giving, Fellows Membership, and Art Collections. He and his wife Ann have been members of the Society of Fellows since 1997. Barrett recently became a trustee of Polytechnic School, and is currently board chair of the Pasadena Conservatory of Music. The Barretts are also Life Trustees of Pacific Oaks.

**Milton Chang** received a bachelor's degree in electrical engineering from the University of Illinois and holds master's and doctoral degrees from Caltech. He serves as a director on the boards of Arcturus Biosciences, OpVista, Rockwell, and YesVideo. Chang is active in the technology and business communities and has received a number of prestigious awards from professional societies, and has been honored with Distinguished Alumni awards from both Caltech and the University of Illinois College of Engineering. Chang is a fellow of the Optical Society of America, past President of IEEE Lasers & Electro-Optics Society, and writes monthly business columns for Laser Focus World and Photonics Spectra. Chang and his wife Rosalind have been Fellows at The Huntington since 2003. Chang serves on the Overseers' Botanical Gardens Committee.

**Kwang-I Yu** was founder, chairman, and CEO of Paracel Inc., a provider of high-throughput genomic and text data analysis products. After Celera Genomics Inc. acquired the company in 2000, Yu served as senior vice president until his retirement in 2002. Prior to founding Paracel, Yu held a number of senior technical positions at TRW Inc., including TRW fellow, director of Coyoteworks (TRW's center for high-throughput computing research), and division chief engineer. Yu holds a bachelor's degree in

physics from the University of Richmond, Va., and a doctorate in computer science from Caltech. He is a trustee of the Keck Graduate Institute of Life Sciences, one of the Claremont colleges. Yu and his wife Ellen have been Fellows at The Huntington since 2003. He is a member of the Overseers' Botanical Gardens Committee.

**Paul Zee**, former South Pasadena mayor and city council member, was born in Shanghai, China, raised in Hong Kong, and came to the United States to attend Point Loma College. He returned to Hong Kong to work in the business field and to study at Poyltechnic University, then moved permanently to the United States in 1977. Zee is president of Zee Management Co. and also owns and operates U.S. Safety & Supply Co., which manufactures industrial safety equipment. At The Huntington, Zee is an active member of the President's Council on the Chinese Garden. Additional community involvement includes the South Pasadena Chinese American Club, of which he is founding president; the South Pasadena Downtown Revitalization Task Force; and CEO (Chinese Elected Officials). He and his wife Jojoe are both regular volunteers at the Chinese American Museum in Los Angeles.
